EXAMPLES OF ACTIONS TO PROTECT THE RESOURCE

Our company participates in the Reforest FMU project.

The project aims to contribute to the sustainable management of Cameroon's timber-producing forests by mobilising private and public stakeholders around reforestation and future forest management strategies. Funded by the EU, it consists of reforestation actions in Cameroon's FMUs. It started at the beginning of 2022 and will run until 2026.

EXAMPLES OF ACTIONS TO PROTECT WILDLIFE

We have reinforced our anti-poaching resources, by setting up checkpoints along FMU access routes and by monitoring illegal activities.



EXAMPLES OF ACTIONS IN FAVOUR OF INDIGENOUS POPULATIONS

Our support of the local populations is demonstrated in many ways: by supplying drinking water, raising awareness and preventing AIDS, donating medication, building the Baka School, building classrooms and by donating agricultural equipment as well as photovoltaic poles for the villages.
