

- 1972** Creation of PALLISCO (Eboumétoum site), Logging and Sawmill
- 1985** Installation of 2nd transformation (drying and planing)
- 1996** Opening of the Mindourou site and creation of CIFM
- 1998** Installation of 3rd transformation (planing)
- 2000** Logging within FMUs as a subcontractor
- 2004** Operational start-up of the 2nd sawmilling line
- 2004** Approval of the first management plans
- 2005** All FMUs «under management».

- 2008** Obtaining of FSC® certification (logs and sawn timber)

OUR MAIN EQUIPMENT

- Construction equipment (bulldozers, skidders, loaders, logging trucks)
- Processing units (sawmill, dryers, planer mill, timber mill, generators)

OUR BEST PRACTICES



EXAMPLES OF ACTIONS TO PROTECT THE RESOURCE

- Removal of 0.8 trees per hectare, as a result of compliance with management plans and FSC certification.
- Minimum diameters below which trees are not harvested (to ensure both regeneration and timber potential).
- Maximum diameters above which trees are not harvested (to increase the number of seed trees and guarantee plant diversity).
- Surveillance of FMU areas to prevent illegal harvesting (fences, patrols, etc.).
- Seed gathering and plant production in nurseries
- Enrichment of logged and damaged areas (28,000 plants/year)
- Monitoring of the ecology of forest species (partnership with ULG Nature+).

EXAMPLES OF ACTIONS TO PROTECT WILDLIFE

- Anti-poaching campaign conducted with local authorities
- Surveillance with camera traps
- Identification of high-risk poaching areas
- Wildlife inventories
- Alternatives to bushmeat consumption (income-generating activities, commissary)
- Bio-monitoring of both large and medium-sized mammals
- Raising awareness of local populations to combat poaching and preserve protected species

EXAMPLES OF ACTIONS IN FAVOUR OF INDIGENOUS POPULATIONS

- Health support (medical equipment, medicines, electrical power)
- Villages' access to electricity (photovoltaics)
- Educational support (classrooms, teaching materials, supplies, tables and benches)
- Agricultural support (farming equipment, seeds)
- Support for the development of income-generating activities (NTFPs, small-scale livestock farming, fishing)
- Organisation of free healthcare campaigns



EXAMPLES OF ACTIONS IN FAVOUR OF EMPLOYEES

- Information/Awareness-raising/Training
- Provision of Personal Protective Equipment
- First-aid training in the workplace
- HIV/AIDS peer educators
- Health insurance plans
- Occupational health and an emergency evacuation plan
- Access to a health centre for staff families and free medication
- Staff housing and construction assistance
- Facilitated access to banking services
- Provision of a wide variety of food products in the commissary
