



High local & global availability





## One international benchmark that is complemented by national requirements developed locally and recognized globally

- National systems are developed locally and recognized globally through endorsement.
- **Endorsement** is our process to ensure that national forest certification systems meet our international requirements.
- There are currently 48 PEFC-endorsed **national forest certification systems** around the world.
- The local-based, bottom-up approach also ensures **consistent and robust delivery** of the international benchmark sustainability requirements
- All national standards meet the same global sustainability requirements whilst at the same time integrating the unique social, economic and environmental conditions at a local level.

This approach respects and facilitates a sustainable mindset, reflecting the diversity of people, their cultures, and their values that in itself mirrors the diversity of sustainable forestry types around the world.

VISION


A world which values the full contributions of sustainable forests.


