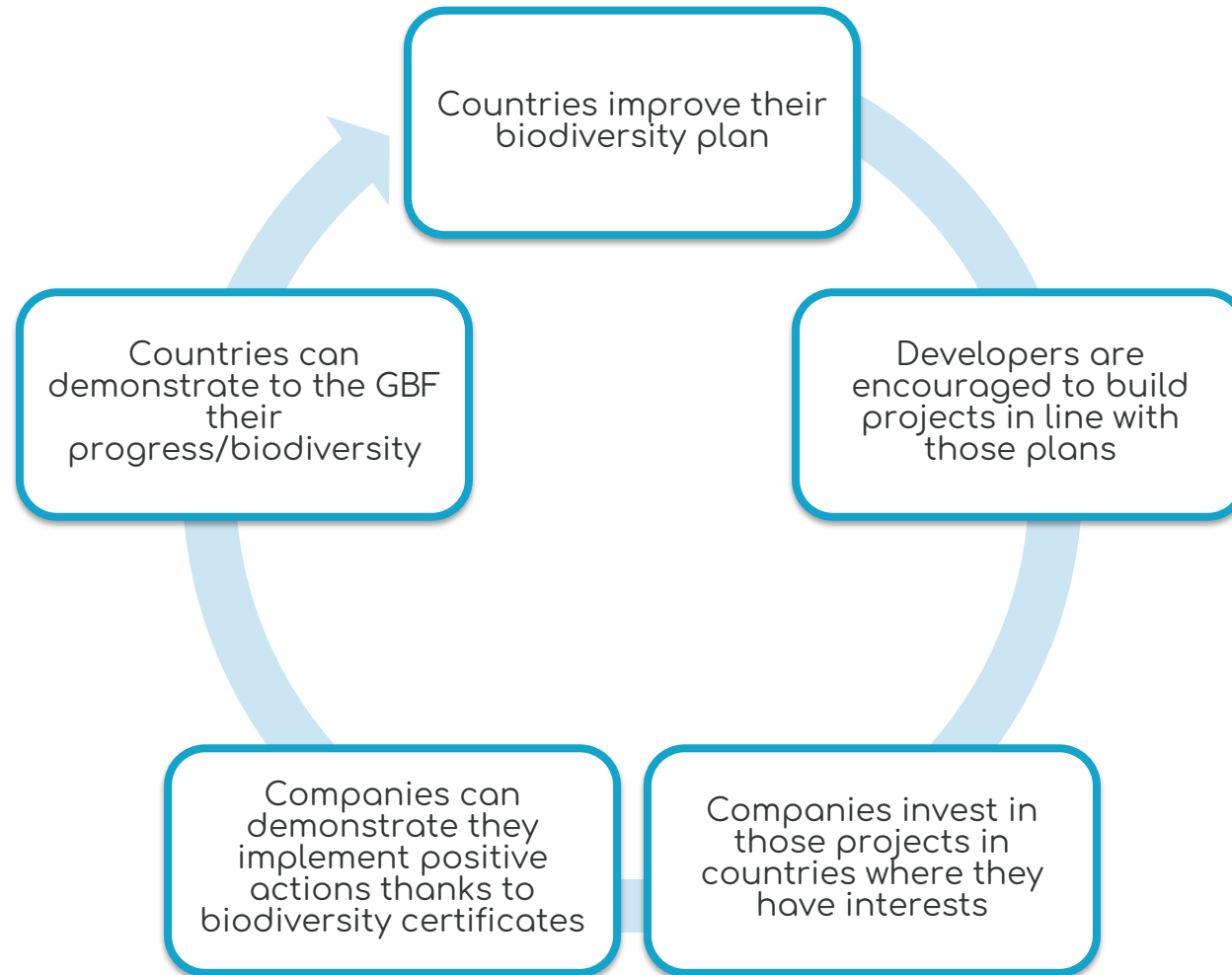

... which translate to the GBF's objectives at national levels.


Plant native tree species (Forest in tropical climate)


Maintain a quantity per hectare of large dead trees (Forest in temperate climate)


"Reduce the frequency of Phytosanitary Treatments and their Toxicity (Agriculture in temperate climate)


The genetic diversity of native, wild and domesticated species is maintained. 

Ensure forests are managed sustainably, through the use of biodiversity to increase resilience. 

Reduce the use of phytosanitary products by 2030. 

"Restoring population of native wild species to healthy and resilient levels." 

"Enhance or even restore ecological connectivity and strengthen ecosystem resilience" 

"Reducing the overall risk from pesticides and highly hazardous chemicals by at least half." 

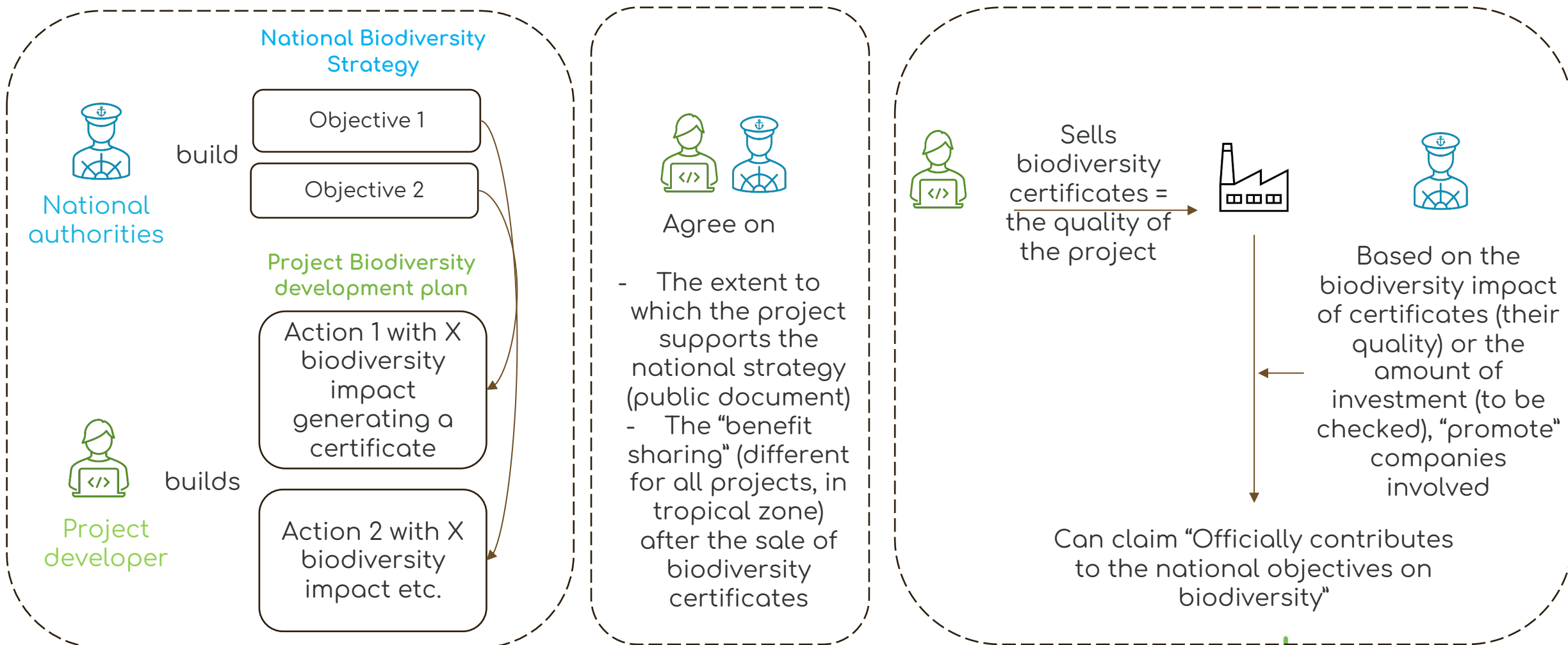
