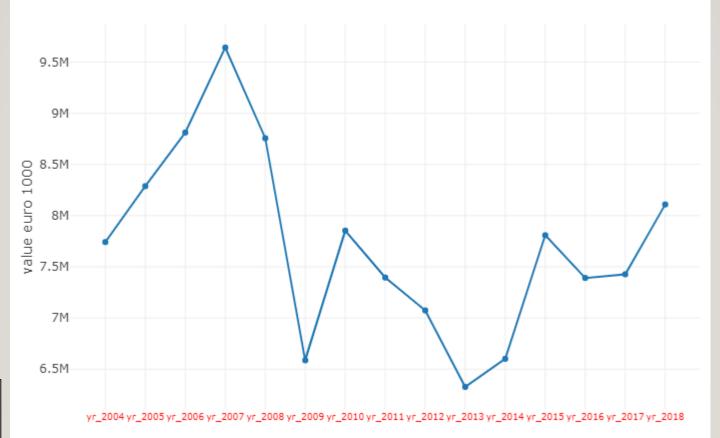
### **CHALLENGES & OPPORTUNITIES**

- Supply pressure of softwood lumber opens up new opportunities
  - Importance of R&D for structural wood use
- Short supply chains are on the rise
- Wood remains an underdog material
  - Importance of national, European and international coordination (lobbying, technical, communication...)
- Structuring and specialisation of the sector
  - Importance of working on the attractiveness of the sector and training

### **CHALLENGES & OPPORTUNITIES**

- Orientation of flows to other markets
- Tropical woods have undeniable qualities
