Electronic traceability tools

- Phase 1: production monitoring and perspectives
- Phase 2: traceability software
- Phase 3: electronic identification, GPS tracking









Transparency recommendations



Clear and commonly applied rules for all companies

- 1. Improved legislative texts, guidelines and control procedures
- 2. Real participatory process for finalisation of these texts
- 3. Review legality grids to become insensible to law changes Law details (verification references) to be included in TLAS

Recommendations for better governance



- Minimise human intervention
 - To avoid mistakes, unnecessary delays and bribery
- Advance stepwise when introducing electronic systems
 - Avoid failure because of complexity
 - Adapt to available infrastructure and ressources
 - Continuous learning
- Start with most urgent or significant problems

Clear and commonly applied rules

- Improved legislation, guidelines and control procedures
- Steady legality grids link governance REDD+
- Proficient independent observation

Stepwise introduction of electronic systems

- Avoid mistakes, bribery
- Raise tax income
- Speed up controls and delivery of authorisations
- Make use of private sector initiatives
