C3: harmonization of EUTR implementation:

Increase awareness in EU of the importance of harmonizing national approaches

 \rightarrow Participation in EUTR events

 \rightarrow Study tours of European actors (CA, MO, federations, EC) in African producing countries





FLEGT-REDD+ projects: EUTR

C3: harmonization of EUTR implementation:

rely on the value of private forest certification

→ training and awareness campaign in UE: \rightarrow Use of private certification in due diligence \rightarrow for european actors (CA, Federations, MO, EC)

- **C4:** Facilitation of EUTR implementation:
- Provide relevant information to implement due diligence
 - \rightarrow Information platform : Timber Trade portal
 - one-stop information center about legal timber trade, due diligence, country requirements and export
 - mainly focused in tropical countries (23 countries profiles)

- Improve best practices in wood and forest sector
- Improve accountability of European operators

Challenges of risk analysis (in DDS):

- **Simplify** information searches





Timber Trade Portal: goals

TTP = Creation of a level playing field

- Improve access to information
- tool that helps operators to
 - comply with EUTR
 - and exercise due diligence

 \rightarrow Enable operators to make their own risk analysis on a case-by-case basis, by giving tools and information \rightarrow Encourage individual accountability of EU operators

Factual, complete and update information


- Provide and centralize reliable and factual information

- News about the EUTR and legality in wood trade


